IASA OPENS CALL FOR CONTENT FOR IASA XCHANGE 2027

Malvern, Pa. (July 1, 2026) – IASA has opened its Call for Content for IASA Xchange™ 2027, inviting insurance professionals to submit session proposals for the annual conference taking place June 6–8, in Orlando, Florida. The educational program is developed from proposals submitted by industry professionals, making the Call for Content an opportunity to help shape the conversations and learning experiences at next year's conference.
