

IASA Xchange[™] Event Health and Safety Protocols

The following guidelines comprise the 2022 IASA Xchange[™] Event and Safety Protocols, which represent state and local mandated protocols in place during the event. Any updates will be posted and shared with registered attendees, exhibitors, sponsors, and vendors, prior to the event.

Registrants must agree to our COVID-19 protocols before they can complete their registration.

Before Leaving Home:

- Follow relevant guidance provided by the <u>Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC)</u>, and/or your local health authority.
- Adhere to government issued travel restrictions and guidance issued by the region you will be traveling to and the region from which you are traveling.
- Stay home if you feel sick, have tested positive for COVID-19, are waiting for COVID-19 test results, or have been in close contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19.

On-site During the Event:

- Follow guidance from the local health authority for everyday preventive actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses including, but not limited to:
 - □ Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, or an alcohol-based sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
 - Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
 - Cover your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing. Throw used tissues in the trash.
 - Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
 - □ Providing proof of a negative COVID-19 taken within 72 hours of the first day of the meeting, if you are unvaccinated.
- Wear a face mask that completely covers your face from the bridge of your nose to past your chin. Neck gaiters, bandanas, and masks with exhaust valves are not acceptable face coverings.
- Go to the event First Aid office at any time if you feel unwell or are experiencing flu-like symptoms.

Adherence to on-site guidelines in place at the time of the event is required. Anyone not adhering to the guidelines will be asked to leave, or will be removed from, the event premises and to surrender his/her event badge and will forfeit their registration fees.

You must attest affirmatively to the following two statements to complete your online registration:
