## Event Safety Protocols

IASA has developed the following event safety protocols for 2022 IASA Xchange™ and OnPOINT events. Any updates will be posted and shared with registered attendees, exhibitors, sponsors, and vendors prior to the event.

### Before Leaving Home:

- Follow relevant guidance provided by the [Centers for Disease Control and Prevention \(CDC\)](#) and/or your local health authority.
- Adhere to government issued travel restrictions and guidance issued by the region you will be traveling to and the region from which you are traveling.
- Stay home if you feel sick, have tested positive for COVID-19, are waiting for COVID-19 test results, or have been in close contact with a person who has tested positive for COVID-19.

### On-site During the Event:

- At this time, masks are recommended.
- Follow guidance from the local health authority for everyday preventive actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses including, but not limited to:
  - Wash hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds or an alcohol-based sanitizer with at least 60% alcohol.
  - Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
  - Cover your nose and mouth when coughing or sneezing. Throw used tissues in the trash.
  - Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces using a regular household cleaning spray or wipe.
  - Providing proof of a negative COVID-19 – taken within 72 hours of the first day of the meeting, if you are unvaccinated due to a medical or religious exemption only.
- Go to the event First Aid office at any time if you feel unwell or are experiencing flu-like symptoms.

Adherence to on-site guidelines in place at the time of the event is required. Anyone not adhering to the guidelines will be asked to leave or will be removed from the event premises and to surrender his/her event badge and will forfeit their registration fees.
